

Treenware

Wares made of treen (Middle English for "Wooden") were used for cooking and serving food in colonial America before pottery was readily available. With its modest design, lustrous patina, and sense of history, Treenware from this period is highly prized by collectors.

Work Spoons

These are the traditional kitchen work spoons used for everything from mixing batters to stirring a large kettle of apple butter.

Serving Spoons

Granny Spoons are reproductions of the utensils that were common in the kitchens of yesteryear and may be found in many antique stores today. A thin flat curved handle rests perfectly in a ladies hand. The bowl is deep enough to serve or shallow enough to just stir a pot. We feel these are the ultimate spoons. They have a thick curved handle and a much deeper bowl, which make these truly a lifetime utensil.
